1941: Captain W Humpage, winner J Wooton who beat A Ridyard



1942: Captain A Ridyard. Arnold Ridyard being very well known in sporting circles throughout Wirral and Tony Taylor being at the zenith of his form, this final drew a great gallery for the afternoon round. The match finished at the 35th. with the secretary, Les McClelland the winner.



1943: Captain J Beckett. To look at this group no one would think it was played right in the middle of the 1939 war. There was a very good turnout with the game won by A Taylor, the loser, Jack Cumberlidge.
